The Dance Captain Program is designed to give Ensemble members an opportunity to lead in a greater capacity, with choreography, mentorship, and administrative assistance.

Requirements:

- High school student for 2021-2022 school year
- At least 1 year of Ensemble experience
- Need not be part of the Pre-Professional Program
- Must participate in all assigned Ensemble dances
- Maintain superior attendance in class and rehearsal
- Able to learn, retain, and execute choreography for multiple dances
- Show exemplary qualities of kindness, leadership, and positivity

Duties:

- Assigned to 1 additional Ensemble dance to assist with choreography, costume, and rehearsals (pending Covid Restrictions)
- Retain choreography for up to 6 Ensemble pieces, plus Disney choreography
- Lead dancers in select rehearsals
- Write down notes from instructors from previous rehearsals and review with dancers prior to start of next rehearsal
- Assist with cleaning dances, that is, give constructive feedback to enhance dances
- Lead warm-ups both at outside performances and at rehearsals
- Pack and prepare for outside events and performances
- Assist with music selection and choreography for Walnut Festival Twilight Parade
- Assist with Disneyland Rehearsals
- Check in dancers at performance call times
- Assist with 2022-2023 Ensemble Auditions
- Assist in choosing Ensemble 2022-2023 Uniform
- Additional responsibilities as assigned
