

Ace Performing Ensemble Dance Captain 2018-2019

The Dance Captain Program is designed to give ensemble members an opportunity to lead in a greater capacity, with choreography, mentorship and administrative assistance.

Requirements:

- High school student for 2018-2019 school year
- At least 1 year of ensemble experience
- Participate in all assigned ensemble dances
- Maintain superior attendance in class and rehearsal
- Able to learn, retain and execute choreography for multiple dances

Duties:

- Assigned to 1 additional ensemble dance to assist with choreography, costume, music selection and rehearsals
- Retain choreography for up to 6 ensemble pieces
- Lead dancers in select rehearsals
- Assist with cleaning dances, that is, give constructive feedback to enhance dances
- Lead warm ups both at outside performances and at rehearsals
- Keep a binder with rehearsal and class absences, lateness or leaving early
- Assist the front desk by emailing a monthly report
- Pack and prepare for all outside events
- Assist with 2019-2020 Ensemble Auditions
- Assist with music selection and choreography for parade
- Assist with Disneyland Rehearsals
- Assist with creating and inputting rehearsal schedule
- Check in dancers at performance call times
- Additional responsibilities as assigned or requested
